3	A	Circle left 20m in diameter	Regularity of trot; shape and size of circle; bend; balance	10		
4	AFXHC	Change rein in working trot rising	Regularity and quality of trot; bend and balance	10		
5	C	Circle right 20m in diameter	Regularity of trot; shape and size of circle; bend; balance	10		
6	Between C & M	Medium Walk	Willing, calm transition; regularity and quality of walk	10		
7	MXK	Change rein at free walk on a loose rein	Regularity; reach and ground cover with overtrack; allowing complete freedom to stretch the neck forward and downward	10
